4 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes, sir.

5 DR. BARD: All right.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: All right, before putting the
7 question, I would like to state my own position. I share
8 to a considerable extent the misgivings expressed by
9 Mr. Sykes and I am going to vote against the motion because
10 it seems to me that the suggested cure for these misgivings
11 and worries, which are very real, is much worse than the
12 disease they would seek to cure.

13 I do not think that the devices such as were
14 used in the Court of Appeals in the Hopkins case is the
15 answer and it seems to me that even though we must recog-
16 nize that there is a real risk, that the Legislature feels
17 it easier to write a check when it doesn't actually have
18 to put its name on it; nevertheless, that is a risk which
19 in today's society we will just have to take.
