soon enough.

DR. BARD: If you start later, you could end later. This is the very concept behind it. There is some flexibility. You can stretch it one way or another but with a closing date there is no place to stretch if you start late.

DR. BURDETTE: The concept Dr. Bard talks
about I have so many reservations about. While we are
not going to allow the legislature to change its salary
except for the next Legislature, I should think that if
it seems to be a good solid year for the party, why not
make the job a \$20,000 a year job and we will all come
back and spend a full year at it.

Then I think Senator Hoff's point that the people who are willing to make their living that way rather than ordinary professions will go in the Legislature. Dr. Bard has the impression that this wouldn't happen. Maybe it wouldn't but I would like to be pretty sure it wouldn't happen or even happen partially. So that you get \$10,000 a year because you meet six months of the year. It makes it look good.
