THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Sykes, I think we would make better time if you will not submit that as an amendment, but save it as a motion to be made after we vote on this one.

MR. SYKES: All right, I will do that.

THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Hoff, I sense that there are

some who would favor your motion if it were for a longer period of time. In the light of the discussion, do you want to stand on the 25 years or do you want to change it?

I would suggest, Mr. Chairman, that MR. HOFF: perhaps after the 25 years is defeated, you might try 30. I assume we have had enough

discussion. In order to move quickly, I propose to submit to you for consideration the section as proposed to be amended with the limitation of 25 years. Following that, if it is defeated, with one submitting 30 years and one submitting 35 years, and then I will recognize Mr. Sykes to submit his motion which could be submitted, regardless of whether the Commission does or does not adopt the year limitation.
