This is two-thirds. I think this 1 MR. SYKES: is as important as the veto. 2 THE CHAIRMAN: I take it, without having the 3 precise language, you would add after the word purpose 4 and before the period, in Line 20, a phrase such as passed 5 by the yea and nay votes of two-thirds of the elected 6 7 members of both houses? MR. SYKES: Yes, sir. 8 THE CHAIRMAN: Is there a second? 9 MRS. FREEDLANDER: I second it. 10 11 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr.Mindel? MR. MINDEL: Mr. Chairman, I think I asked 12 Mr. Case that question earlier, and I don't know how 13 responsive you were, Dick. Would that affect the financing 14 insofar as the State is concerned and, also, do any other 15 States have an extraordinary vote required to pledge the 16 17 credit? No. As far as I know, there is 18 MR. CASE: another -- I hate to mention this because Mr. Sykes will 19 20 put this into a motion, too --21 MR. SYKES: I accept it.
