

1 Delaware, for example, a three-fourths vote is required
2 for a debt. There are some States that require a referen-
3 dum on one issue. However, there are more detailed pro-
4 cedures regarding particular debts in various States than
5 there are here. So, there are some.

6 MR. SYKES: My limitation was only with regard
7 to credit, with regard to the State.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: Let me ask you if you are
9 intending your motion as I have phrased it also as to a
10 gift of asset?

11 MR. SYKES: Yes.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: So that a gift to Hopkins to aid
13 it would require a two-thirds vote?

14 MR. SYKES: Yes, sir.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Case, I would like to ask
16 you whether this would in your opinion pose perhaps almost
17 impossible problems in connection with the budget?
18 Doesn't the budget sometimes contain these outright grants
19 to non-State agencies?

20 MR. CASE: I think where you have -- you mean a
21 straight gift of cash?
