certainly be permitted. I think Judge Adkins will have the opportunity to vote on that question as we put up the question now under discussion because the only thing added to it is the provision that it can be called into special session by the Governor and that it meet at a stipulated date in January, convene at a stipulated date in January.

DR. BARD: I don't want to prolong this
but I have to go back to Judge Adkins' point. If it is
true that some individuals would prefer that there not
be lengthy sessions this very concept permits a very
short session. I think the moment you set forth a target
date, then quite often a legislative body will extend
the requirements. Whether they need the 70 or 90 days
or not, they feel here it is, we will make use of it.
This is merely saying you use only that portion you
need. Some years it will be short, some years it will
be very long. It does not say it need be long. It
merely says that you determine the cloth according to
what your need is in this particular year.
