

1 and, in addition, I have suggested to the Chairman that
2 he assume you have read and understand the background and
3 the comments and that, in the absence of questions, he
4 will hold his presentation of each section to a minimum.

5 We have already been through a substantial
6 part of this Article. One question arising at the very
7 beginning which must be resolved at some point, and it
8 has now been debated so long and extensively by the
9 Committee and again by the Commission, that I think we
10 should resolve it and resolve it now at the very outset
11 and without any great debate.

12 I refer to Section 1, at Page 10. At the last
13 meeting of the Commission a motion to approve this section
14 was tabled. I will entertain a motion to remove that
15 motion from the table and act on it today, and the question
16 related to the nomenclature, the names of the courts, the
17 Supreme Court, the Appellate Court and the Superior Court
18 and the District Court.
