to remove from the table the motion to approve Section 1.

Are you ready for the question? All those in favor of the motion please signify by saying aye. Contrary, no.

The ayes have it.

The motion now before you is a motion to approve Section 1, the judicial power of the State is vested exclusively in a unified judicial system composed of the Supreme Court, the Appellate Court, the Superior Court and the District Court.

Mr. Martineau, any comments?

MR. MARTINEAU: Mr. Chairman, perhaps this is the best thing to do on this particular section. I thought we would proceed as we did with the other sections and that would be to have them approved, unless someone makes a motion to change them.
