The ayes seem to have it but let's have a show of hands.

Those in favor signify by raising hands. Opposed. Twelve to six. The ayes have it.

This would seem to make it unnecessary to put up the other questions but if any member desires to take the vote of the Commission on the subordinate questions, I would be glad to put them. Not subordinate questions but the alternates. All right. If not, we will move to the next.

But before doing that, I would like to interrupt the consideration of this report and take this opportunity which gives me real pleasure to present to the Commission Judge John B. Gray, Jr. As I indicated this morning, he has been named by the Governor as Chairman of the Citizens Committee for the Constitutional Referendum. Serving with him is Dr. Winslow as Vice-Chairman. Judge Gray is just on his way back home from New York and agreed to stop in today to meet the Commission and say hello. I would like to present him at this time. Judge Gray.
