gentlemen, inasmuch as it will apparently be part of my job to sell your product, at least sell to the people of the State the necessity or desirability of establishing by referendum a constitutional convention to deal with your product, it is a pleasure for me to meet with you and see how you work. At least I can say to the people of the state, as I have not attempted to meet with them, the kind of study you have given this proposal.

I really am an amateur at this business of selling to the people of the state policies of this sort. It was only a few days ago that I was invited to chair this citizens group. I am happy to do it because, as you all know, and I know, of course, our constitution is quite antiquated in many respects and certainly contains a great deal of statutory matter really that ought to be in statutes rather than the basic law of the land. From a lawyer's standpoint, I think it is a pretty sorry instrument. I am sure your production will be very much better and that we ought to have no difficulty in convincing the voters of the state that this does constitute a first class opportunity
