would be using the term venue more in the jurisdictional 1 sense, jurisdiction of the particular court over a 2 defendant's residing or over causes arising and so forth. 3 Any further questions? Any further discussion? 4 JUDGE ADKINS: Am I to understand that my Б question is to be considered by the Committee? 6 I would assume so. We're not THE CHAIRMAN: 7 adopting this finally as language, because this hasn't 8 been considered and I would take it that your suggestion 9 would be considered by the Committee. Mr. Clagett? 10 MR. CLAGETT: Just a question for clarification. 11 Does this provision, that is, this alternate provision 12 making the rule paramount over the legislative enactment 13 do any injustice to Constitutional theory, and it seems 14 to me --15 THE CHAIRMAN: No. I don't think so. 16 Let me --MR.
