of election and was a qualified voter in the state. But it would not be necessary for such person to be a resident of the county or legislative district which he would represent.

It is this one I suspect we should take separately. Two parts here. We may want to vote on the one year clause. It is now three years. The second part in which we say he would not need to be a resident of the county or legislative district and this is now one year.

Next the person should be eligible as a Senator, upon attaining the age of 25 and Delegate upon attaining the age of 21, that is as it is now.

The new constitution should contain no provision to the effect that a minister or preacher of the Gospel or any religious creed or denomination shall not be eligible as a Senator or Delegate.
