to include this. The present Constitution requires a 1 residency of only six months in the particular county 2 where the vacancy exists. This only requires you to 3 prognosticate a little further in advance. 4 I don't think six months is any real protection, 5 if you know a judicial vacancy is going to exist, or one 6 year or two years. All of these requirements, any arti-7 ficial requirements of time admitted to the Bar, residency, 8 time of residency really don't have a great deal to do with 9 the quality of the persons who are nominated to be judge. 10 That is achieved by a nominating type of system. 11 Actually, the Committee would feel that none 12 of these things would have to be put in. You don't even 13 have to have a requirement that they be members of the Bar, 14 on the assumption the nominating committee is not going 15 to recommend anyone who is not a member of the Bar. 16 Well, I think perhaps you are MR. MILLER: 17 right. 18 MR. MARTINEAU: We thought this resident 19 requirement has gone far enough, but to go any further 20

really isn't adding anything.
