4 I might add quickly that I have no desire or
5 ambition to be a Judge, so --

6 MRS. BOTHE: I think the problem would be
7 solved much more quickly by simply striking the entire
8 paragraph. As Bob indicated, the Committee isn't in love
9 with this provision. We felt, I think, perhaps the majority
10 of us felt it was really unnecessary to make any provision
11 that a Judge be a resident of the county or district or
12 anywhere else, except perhaps a citizen of the State and
13 I would move, if I may, that Paragraph 3 of Section 9-A
14 be deleted.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Paragraph 3, you mean the second
16 paragraph?

17 MRS. BOTHE: It's the third paragraph.

18 MR. MINDEL: Second and third.

19 MRS. BOTHE: Of course, in the second paragraph,
20 the problem isn't as acute because the circuit would
21 encompass a wider area.
