suggested, that a man could be appointed to a vacancy ٦ either in the place where he resides or where he regularly 2 conducts his practice. 3 I might add quickly that I have no desire or 4 ambition to be a Judge, so --5 MRS. BOTHE: I think the problem would be 6 solved much more quickly by simply striking the entire 7 paragraph. As Bob indicated, the Committee isn't in love 8 with this provision. We felt, I think, perhaps the majority 9 of us felt it was really unnecessary to make any provision 10 that a Judge be a resident of the county or district or 11 anywhere else, except perhaps a citizen of the State and 12 I would move, if I may, that Paragraph 3 of Section 9-A 13 be deleted. 14 THE CHAIRMAN: Paragraph 3, you mean the second 15 paragraph? 16 It's the third paragraph. MRS. BOTHE: 17 Second and third. MR. MINDEL: 18 Of course, in the second paragraph, MRS. BOTHE: 19 the problem isn't as acute because the circuit would 20 encompass a wider area.
