Russell's Committee has dealt a little bit with this or is it miscellaneous --

MR. RUSSELL: Miscellaneous committee.

DR. BARD: Four might be delayed. As for the first three recommendations, I shall comment mainly on Recommendation One and Three, Two should not bring very much debate.

It is the view of the Committee that we ought to lower the state residency requirement to one since there is a good deal of mobility in America, especially in a state like Maryland, which is the third most rapidly growing state in population east of the Mississippi River. We think we would get possibly better people to run if we lowered this to one year.

As for eliminating the residential requirement for county or legislative district, we think that since the Senate now does not necessarily recognize each county as such and since the state as a who, that this is not necessarily a requirement of securificance.

I might add there was a little more difference
