reasonable times, whether court is in session or not, in 1 2 the general vicinity. Now, if either you or Mr. Case were on the 3 Bench in Baltimore, I would be delighted if you wanted it. 4 and you would still be accessible in the Metropolitan area; 5 but when you are dependent on maybe one Judge in a vicinity 6 and you need to get him for extraordinary reasons and if 7 he were living somewhere many, many miles out of the district 8 I'm not so much concerned about the appointment, but it 9 seems to me that a Judge should be reasonably available 10 to the population and the Bar in the area he is the Judge 11 for or, at least -- also, in Baltimore there are many 12 Judges. If one is away, you can get another one. Some-13 times, in these county circuits, if the resident Judge is 14 away, you have to chase miles to get an urgent order. 15 Judge Adkins? THE CHAIRMAN: 16 Mr. Chairman, I opened this 17 JUDGE ADKINS: Pandora's box and I am now sorry I opened my mouth. 18 I should have to speak in strenuous opposition to Mrs. 19 Bothe's proposal. Coming from a section of the State that 20

is less populous than some of the rest of you come from,

21
