

1 in the people, I think that all sections of the State  
2 should be represented and the only way to preserve that  
3 is to provide for a residential requirement.

4 I would therefore strenuously urge that  
5 Mrs. Bothe's proposal be defeated.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: Let me cut across this discussion  
7 and make a correction. I had said at the outset of the  
8 discussion this afternoon that we had gotten down to  
9 Section 9-C in our consideration last week. I thought  
10 we had finished the complete preliminary review and had  
11 gotten that far in going over it section by section.

12 Mr. Brooks and Mr. Martineau have called my  
13 attention to the fact that this is not so. We got to  
14 Section 9-C in the preliminary review and therefore we  
15 have never had any presentation, much less discussion,  
16 of the remainder of the section.

17 I think, for the same reasons that we decided  
18 on that course of action with respect to this Article  
19 initially, it would be well to follow it. So, rather  
20 than to take the vote on this question now, let us go on  
21 to a presentation of the complete Article by the Committee
