and then we can come back and take it up section by section as we have been doing with respect to the other

MR. MARTINEAU: Mr. Chairman, I don't know whether this is going to go over very well or not, but frankly, we did make a reasonably thorough review of the sections up to 8, the first time around, although it wasn't complete. We did consider a number of suggestions that the members of the Commission made. We even had some votes on it, as witness the vote on Section 7, and to avoid the necessity of going through Sections 2 through 8 all over again, it might be appropriate, unless there is an objection, to consider a motion to approve those sections.

THE CHAIRMAN: I would rather have you present

THE CHAIRMAN: I would rather have you present
to us what changes you have made in them before you do that.
That could be done and I think should be done. I don't
mean now. You can do it tomorrow morning, for instance.
However, let's get the complete picture of the Committee's
report with respect to selection of judges and then we can
come back and pick up the pieces.
