Let's go on with the presentation of Section 9, 1 beginning with B, without getting into more detail than 2 is necessary to present it adequately. 3 Mr. Chairman, as a point of inquiry, MR. CASE: 4 would it be proper for the Commission members not to ask 5 questions or engage in the kind of debate we have just 6 done, but merely let Mr. Martineau go ahead and clarify --7 I think you can ask questions, THE CHAIRMAN: 8 9 but not debate. MR. CASE: Clarifying questions. 10 11 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes. MR. MARTINEAU: Starting off with 9-B, relating 12 to nominations and appointments, I think we covered this 13 the last time. In fact, I'm sure of it. 14 Whenever a vacancy occurs in a judicial office-15 I'm not going to read this. Is that all right, Mr. Chairman? 16 THE CHAIRMAN: Go ahead. 17 MR. MARTINEAU: I will just summarize it and 18 complete it as quickly as possible. Whenever a vacancy 19 occurs, the Governor must appoint from a list of two to 20 five persons from a nominating commission. The nominating 21
