Even though each lawyer has in his heart a desire --1 I think, notwithstanding Mr. Case's remark, each lawyer 2 has a desire to be a judge. 3 MR. CASE: Speak for yourself, Robert. 4 DR. BURDETTE: Who are the non-judicial, 5 Mr. Martineau? And how can you say the Chief Judge's 6 term is for four years? I'm sorry. Is this going to be 7 cleared, because I've always read that lawyers are officers 8 of the court, but they are non-judicial. 9 That's right. Since we have 10 THE CHAIRMAN: had this interruption, let me break in for a moment. 11 12 (Discussion held off the record.) THE CHAIRMAN: All right, go ahead. 13 MR. MARTINEAU: C(2) provides for trial courts 14 nominating commissions. The Legislature shall establish 15 the number of nominating commissions. This can vary from 16 time to time, as determined by law. Each commission shall 17 make nominations for vacancies in the office of Superior 18 Court Judge or the District Court Judge, for the county 19 or counties or district for which the trial courts nominat-20 ing commission is established and this, as I explained 21
