

1 commission shall be elected by lawyers throughout the
2 State. Elections for lawyer members of nominating com-
3 missions, including the qualifications of lawyer members
4 and of their electors, shall be governed by the rule of
5 the Superior Court.

6 Section 4 provides that lay members of the
7 Appellate Courts nominating commission are to be appointed
8 by the Governor. The Appellate Courts members can come
9 from any place in the State. The Trial Court nominating
10 commission members must come from the particular area from
11 which the nominating commission is established.

12 JUDGE ADKINS: Is there any provision in here
13 for assigning responsibility for the holding of elections
14 for lawyer members, or is that left to legislation?

15 MR. MARTINEAU: That is left to rule. You can
16 see that in Section 3: Elections for lawyer members of
17 nominating commissions, including the qualifications of
18 lawyer members and of their electors, shall be governed
19 by rule.

20 JUDGE ADKINS: By the same token, that would
21 also provide for some system of nomination?
