All right, go ahead, Section 5. THE CHAIRMAN: 1 Section 5, Rules Governing MR. MARTINEAU: 2 Nominating Commissions. A commission may act only on the 3 concurrence of a majority of its current membership. They 4 elect their own chairman, and there is a prohibition against 5 a non-judicial member of a commission holding a public 6 office of profit or an office in a political party while 7 a member of a commission and for six months thereafter. 8 The members of a commission shall have no compensation. 9 Mr. Chairman, I make a comment 10 DR. BURDETTE: that I'm a little fearful of the total effect of not being 11 able to hold office for six months thereafter, because I'm 12 afraid it will have the effect of making ineligible some 13 very able people for office, by forgetting not to resign 14 15 in time. This can be discussed. THE CHAIRMAN: 16 All right. 17 DR. BURDETTE: MR. MARTINEAU: Section 10 is the term of ìĤ office for judges. The judges, first of all, after their 19 appointment will serve a probationary period of two to 20 four years, depending upon the relation of their appointment 21
