

1 to the time for the next general election. In other words,
2 they must serve for two years prior to running in a non-
3 competitive election and running in the first election
4 after they have been in office for two years, and then
5 their full time is provided to be fourteen years.

6 The election procedure is set forth here.

7 It has, as has been explained, a non-competitive election
8 procedure. The Justices of the Supreme Court and the
9 Appellate Court are voted on by the electorate of the
10 entire State. The Judges of the Superior Court and the
11 District Court are subject to approval or rejection by
12 the electorate of the county or district which he is
13 required to -- of course, you can change the residency
14 requirement. You can also put in here that the Supreme
15 Court by rule shall provide for the poll of the lawyers,
16 as to whether or not he should be retained in office.
17 And further, in the event of a rejection of a judge, the
18 job will be filled by --
