

1 THE CHAIRMAN: You mean the clerk himself, or
2 are you including in that term the deputy?

3 JUDGE ADKINS: I am including the chief clerk
4 of each court would not have the benefit of civil service?

5 MR. MARTINEAU: That is right. He would be in
6 the same position Mr. Young is in the Court of Appeals.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further questions? Then I
8 think we ought to go back and go through a consideration
9 of the entire Article, section by section.

10 In view of the detailed presentation, I would
11 hope that we could hold to a minimum the re-presentation,
12 if that is a proper term. I think we better refer to the
13 sections as they are in the report, so you would have the
14 comments. We have already approved Section 1. We go to
15 Section 2, which appears on Page 15, that is, Section 2-A.

16 MR. MARTINEAU: I think it would be better to
17 read it at this point.

18 THE CHAIRMAN: All right.

19 MR. MARTINEAU: The Supreme Court shall be the
20 highest court of the State and shall have such jurisdiction
21 as provided by law.
