This is exactly the same as stated in the 1 report you received in August. 2 THE CHAIRMAN: Any comment? In the absence 3 of any objection, we will follow the usual procedure that 4 it is approved unless there is a change suggested. Is there 5 any further comment or question? If not, we will consider 6 7 Paragraph B, Page 16. MR. MARTINEAU: Paragraph B, on Page 16, 8 Composition. The Supreme Court shall be composed of a 9 Chief Justice and six associate justices. Four justices 10 shall constitute a quorum, and the concurrence of four 11 shall be necessary for the decision of a case. 12 Now, the only change from the earlier draft of 13 August is that we deleted the words concerning the division 14 of the State into appellate districts. We already consider 15 16 that when we --THE CHAIRMAN: In other words, you deleted the 17 language from this section, but not the idea. 18 MR. MARTINEAU: Not the idea. 19 Mr. Miller? THE CHAIRMAN: Any question? 20 I would like to know -- apparently, 21 MR. MILLER:
