

1 This is exactly the same as stated in the
2 report: you received in August.

3 THE CHAIRMAN: Any comment? In the absence
4 of any objection, we will follow the usual procedure that
5 it is approved unless there is a change suggested. Is there
6 any further comment or question? If not, we will consider
7 Paragraph B, Page 16.

8 MR. MARTINEAU: Paragraph B, on Page 16,
9 Composition. The Supreme Court shall be composed of a
10 Chief Justice and six associate justices. Four justices
11 shall constitute a quorum, and the concurrence of four
12 shall be necessary for the decision of a case.

13 Now, the only change from the earlier draft of
14 August is that we deleted the words concerning the division
15 of the State into appellate districts. We already considered
16 that when we --

17 THE CHAIRMAN: In other words, you deleted the
18 language from this section, but not the idea.

19 MR. MARTINEAU: Not the idea.

20 THE CHAIRMAN: Any question? Mr. Miller?

21 MR. MILLER: I would like to know -- apparently,
