3 THE CHAIRMAN: It would have to be.

4 MR. MARTINEAU: I'm sorry, we did make one
5 change. Excuse me. We added the words, of a case, after
6 the very last word. It was originally for a decision and
7 we changed it to a decision of a case. This is to permit
8 the court or one member of the court as it does now, to
9 sign orders granting motions for extending time or such
10 things as that.

11 JUDGE ADKINS: Mr. Chairman, I object to cutting
12 the quorum to four. I think it is not unrealistic to ask
13 for a quorum of at least five out of seven. I would sug-
14 gest that the quorum be changed to five. I don't think
15 that is unreasonable, out of a seven man court.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: You so move?

17 JUDGE ADKINS: Yes, I so move.

18 THE CHAIRMAN: Any second?

19 DR. BURDETTE: I second it.
