The Appellate Court shall have such Ŀ jurisdiction as provided by law. 5 This is exactly the same provision as we had 6 the last time. 7 Mr. Chairman, would the Committee DR. BURDETTE: A agree to such language as the Appellace Court shall have 9 the jurisdiction provided by law? Once before we had this 10 problem of the rather queasy language of saying such juris-11 diction as provided by law, when really what that means is 12 such jurisdiction as be, or may be, with some verb in there, 13 provided by law. 14 Would it meet your approval if THE CHAIRMAN: 15 we said may be after as? 16 DR.
