8 county and then leave it to the district that the judge

12 has nothing to do with eligibility. This requires that
13 once a judge is appointed, he has to reside in the county.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes, but that is the point that
15 we were --

16 MRS. BOTHE: It has to do with accessibility.

17 MR. MARTINEAU: Perhaps we ought to ask Judge
18 Adkins if he has any objection?

19 JUDGE ADKINS: I have no objection to this
