2 MR. CLAGETT: You mean the first time or second  
3 time, because the first statement by Judge Adkins was not -

4 MR. CASE: I supported his first statement and  
5 I support it now.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: He said he didn't want it to go  
7 on there.

8 JUDGE ADKINS: My first statement was a mistake.

9 MR. CLAGETT: And I agree with that.

10 MR. MILLER: I might say, Mr. Chairman, in  
11 talking against my idea of accessibility, it would seem to  
12 me unnecessary to have an associate judge or resident in  
13 each county. If the Chief Judge resided in the county,  
14 I don't think it would be necessary to have an associate  
15 judge in that county, but I do think there ought to be one  
16 judge in each county.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: I think that is what the Committee  
18 intended, is it not, Mr. Martineau?

19 MR. MILLER: It is not what it says.

20 MR. CASE: He's right about that. This can be  
21 read, there should be a Chief Judge in every county.
