1 what he says, too. MR. CLAGETT: You mean the first time or second 2 time, because the first statement by Judge Adkins was not -3 I supported his first statement and MR. CASE: 4 I support it now. 5 THE CHAIRMAN: He said he didn't want it to go 6 7 on there. JUDGE ADKINS: My first statement was a mistake. 8 MR. CLAGETT: And I agree with that. 9 I might say, Mr. Chairman, in 10 MR. MILLER: talking against my idea of accessibility, it would seem to 11 me unnecessary to have an associate judge or resident in 12 each county. If the Chief Judge resided in the county, 13 I don't think it would be necessary to have an associate 14 judge in that county, but 1 do think there ought to be one 15 16 judge in each county. THE CHAIRMAN: I think that is what the Committee 17 intended, is it not, Mr. Martineau? 18 It is not what it says. 19 MR. MILLER: MR. CASE: He's right about that. This can be 20

read, there should be a Chief Judge in every county.

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
