1 every county there has got to be at least one resident judge other than the Chief Judge, and that is what comma 2 to us indicated. 3 If it wasn't artistically stated, it was meant 4 to be, but I thought that was clearly stated. 5 MR. MARTINEAU: My recollection in discussing 6 this with particularly Judge Powers and Judge Diggs, 7 that this wasn't necessary, to require an additional judge 8 to replace the Chief Judge when he is away from a particu-9 lar spot, that the judicial business in that particular 10 county could be continued to be carried on. I might ask 11 our reporter to either confirm or dispute what I just said. 12 The conclusion in that debate 13 MR. RODOWSKY: was that rather than require that, by virtue of the desig-14 nation of Chief Judge, if a vacancy in the county from 15 which the man designated as Chief Judge arose, that an effort 16 would be made to cover that particular county by assignment 17
