2 judge other than the Chief Judge, and that is what comma
3 to us indicated.

4 If it wasn't artistically stated, it was meant
5 to be, but I thought that was clearly stated.

6 MR. MARTINEAU: My recollection in discussing
7 this with particularly Judge Powers and Judge Diggs,
8 that this wasn't necessary, to require an additional judge
9 to replace the Chief Judge when he is away from a particu-
10 lar spot, that the judicial business in that particular
11 county could be continued to be carried on. I might ask
12 our reporter to either confirm or dispute what I just said.

13 MR. RODOWSKY: The conclusion in that debate
14 was that rather than require that, by virtue of the desig-
15 nation of Chief Judge, if a vacancy in the county from
16 which the man designated as Chief Judge arose, that an effort
17 would be made to cover that particular county by assignment
18 of judges and if the problem became acute, then there would
19 have to be provided an additional judgeship, rather than
20 going through the trouble of creating a judgeship in the
21 county the vacancy is created in.
