MR. CASE: Well, I think, as a Committee, I think we considered it at length and in depth.

THE CHAIRMAN: I think Mr. Martineau means we weren't considering the entire structure of the State system as the present draft is preparing to do.

MR. BOND: I will make a motion to get it out of the way.

THE CHAIRMAN: What is it?

MR. BOND: My additional motion is that there be, in addition to the language -- how about helping me, Mr. Case? What did your Committee -- what I'd like is that the concurrent jurisdiction be set by law, that the jurisdiction of the District Court shall be uniform throughout the State.

MR. CASE: I think you can say the District

Court shall have uniform original jurisdiction as may be

provided by law and such concurrent jurisdiction as may

be --

THE CHAIRMAN: I don't think you have to do that to accomplish the purpose. All you have to do is add the word exclusive in front of the second sentence,
