I might say I think the more I consider the point made before about the confusion between Chief Judge and Associate Judge, the way this is phrased, it is well founded and it might be the better thing to do, to provide for Associate Judges and let the other section relating to Chief Judges handle the problem. Nevertheless. I'll continue on.

The State shall be divided by law into districts. There shall be a division of the District Court for each district. Each district shall be composed of one or more entire and contiguous counties.

This is a little more of a change in the language of the section as previously proposed to you. It is not intended to change the meaning of it.

MR. CLAGETT:

Any question? Any comment? THE CHAIRMAN:

I merely want to clarify the question asked me here, whether Calvert or Somerset would be considered as contiguous counties, and I was answering that question, in the light of our earlier discussion, because the river -- the two counties run to the middle of the river and, therefore, they would be contiguous.
