constitution as to other offices, Judges, for instance, which have no relation to the travel requirements.

MR. SAYRE: There could be flexibility as to whether they could be a Judge serving a circuit from which they are not a resident.

THE CHAIRMAN: It isn't true now.

MR. SAYRE: That is true but we are getting more and more away from that as a trend.

DR. JENKINS: It seems this is a rather innocuous item. First it is not going to happen often. Second the decision is made by the electorate of the district.

One other point that came up in Committee is that in the future when we are going to have more redistricting as a result of a census than we have now this would enable an electorate to retain a representative who might be redistricted out of that particular district. But the essential thing is it is up to the people in that district. I just don't think this is really objectionable.
