chief judge of the Superior Court shall, under the direction of the chief justice, prepare and transmit to the governor the estimate of expenditures of the judicial department, which shall be included in the budget without revision.

The chief judge of the Appellate Court shall assist the chief justice in the administration of the Appellate Court. The chief judge of the District Court shall assist the chief judge of the Superior Court in the administration of the District Court.

Now, one point in here that is perhaps

especially worthy of comment is the proviso that the budget for the Judiciary Department shall be prepared by the chief judge under the direction of the chief justice which is to be given to the Governor and included in the budget without revision. This matter came up at the last meeting of the Commission as to what control the Judiciary ought to have over its budget. We had some communication with the Committee on Finance and Taxation. They indicated to us that they hadn't really considered this and had no views on it.
