to Mrs. Freedlander's observation that I believe the present provision in the Constitution is not as broad as this one. It provides that the -- here is the language: Article V, Subsection 11 of Section 52.

The estimates of the Judiciary as provided by law certified by the Comptroller shall be transmitted and so forth. So that the estimates of the Judiciary included in the budget are those that the Legislature by law has heretofore provided.

Is there any discussion of the motion? You ready for the question? All those in favor, signify by saying Aye. Contrary, No.

So ordered. Any further question with respect to Section 6?

MR. MARTINEAU: What we are talking about, Mr. Chairman, are the words at the end of the fourth paragraph of that Section which states, which shall be included in the budget without revision.

I think other than that, we can approve the entire Section without any difficulty, and it is only the effect of those words that is subject to this motion.
