

1 to Mrs. Freedlander's observation that I believe the
2 present provision in the Constitution is not as broad
3 as this one. It provides that the -- here is the language:
4 Article V, Subsection 11 of Section 52.

5 The estimates of the Judiciary as provided
6 by law certified by the Comptroller shall be transmitted --
7 and so forth. So that the estimates of the Judiciary
8 included in the budget are those that the Legislature
9 by law has heretofore provided.

10 Is there any discussion of the motion? You
11 ready for the question? All those in favor, signify by
12 saying Aye. Contrary, No.

13 So ordered. Any further question with respect
14 to Section 6?

15 MR. MARTINEAU: What we are talking about,
16 Mr. Chairman, are the words at the end of the fourth
17 paragraph of that Section which states, which shall be
18 included in the budget without revision.

19 I think other than that, we can approve the
20 entire Section without any difficulty, and it is only the
21 effect of those words that is subject to this motion.
