

1 The State shall be divided by law into cir-
2 cuits of the Supreme Court and into circuits of the
3 Appellate Court. To be eligible for nomination and
4 appointment to the Supreme Court or to the Appellate
5 Court, a person shall reside in the circuit where the
6 vacancy exists.

7 To be eligible for nomination and appointment
8 to the Superior Court or to the District Court, a person
9 shall be a resident of the county or district, respec-
10 tively, where the vacancy exists.

11 MR. MARTINEAU: Now, when we left this yester-
12 day, there was a motion under discussion.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes, to amend the first para-
14 graph, Paragraph A, to require for eligibility that the
15 person be a resident of the State and to eliminate the
16 second and third paragraphs. I think that was Mrs. Bothe's
17 motion. We were discussing at that time, and my recollec-
18 tion is that Mr. Miller had the floor, and I cut him off.
19 Did you want to resume now, Mr. Miller?

20 MR. MILLER: I don't think so at this time.
21 I may.
