recommendation, but that if it is a closed vote, I 1 think, my understanding is that alternate recommendations 2 are always open to inclusion. 3 THE CHAIRMAN: I don't think I made myself 4 I am not suggesting that the Commission not take 5 a position, but if your motion prevails, that that 6 would be included in the draft and what is here would be 7 in the alternate. If your motion fails, then what is 8 included in the draft would be the recommendation and the 9 subject matter of your motion would be the alternate. 10 11 that acceptable? 12 MRS. BOTHE: Yes. MR. MARTINEAU: Mr. Chairman, I would like to 13 make two comments which are in effect contradictory, but 14 I think it is important that the Commission have both 15 factors before it when it votes. 16 First of all, I don't think there is any point 17

in which the Special Committee of the State Bar Association was more insistent upon them on this point of having appellate circuits and having residency requirements for Superior and District Court judges.
