

1 up these two paragraphs so that we can vote on each
2 separately?

3 THE CHAIRMAN: Do you wish to do that, Mrs.
4 Bothe?

5 MRS. BOTHE: Yes.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: All right then, let me state
7 what I would understand to be the motion, and if it is
8 not acceptable, Mrs. Bothe, you can indicate.

9 The first motion would be that the Commission
10 recommend a draft of Paragraph A in which the first para-
11 graph be amended to indicate the requirement that the
12 person to be eligible for judicial office be a resident of
13 the State of Maryland. The second paragraph would be
14 eliminated, and the third paragraph would be retained.

15 Then we will submit separately the question of
16 eliminating from the prepared draft the third paragraph.
17 Are you ready for the question? A vote in favor of the
18 motion would result in the preferred draft containing the
19 substance of the present first paragraph amended to pro-
20 vide for a residency in the State for a person to be
21 eligible for appointment. No paragraph corresponding to the
