motion.

MR. MARTINEAU: Oh, excuse ma.

JUDGE ADKINS: No, X asked the question if the Committee considered it, and Mr. Case took the ball from that point. If the motion is to be made, I prefer Mr. Case make it.

MRS. BOTHE: Before we go on to that, a point of clarification on the last vote. In view of the vote on the elimination of Paragraph 3, I would suppose an alternate would be appropriate since I believe I was the only proponent of that. I don't think my vote is that weighty, so I trust we are only going to propose an

THE CHAIRMAN: Well, we can do that.

alternate on Paragraph 2, is that correct?

MRS. BOTHE: As the mover in that instance, I would suggest we do that.

THE CHAIRMAN: I think the Report should be clarified by indicating that if the Convention desired not to require residence, they could eliminate this or that paragraph depending on how far they would go.
