3 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes.

4 DR. BURDETTE: A question. I couldn't quite
5 hear that answer. I was about to move, Mr. Chairman,
6 an entirely separate motion, that some residency in the
7 State be required. Has that been done?

8 THE CHAIRMAN: It has. Any further questions
9 with respect to Paragraph A?

10 MR. CASE: Well, I think that it should be
11 brought to the attention of the Commission that this
12 paragraph as it is written following as it does the
13 present practice of selecting judges on the basis of
14 residency only deprives the Bench of a pool of manpower
15 that in many ways is a tragic thing.

16 You always talk about trying to get the best
17 people to serve on the Bench and yet, this provision
18 eliminates a great many of the best people who might other-
19 wise be willing to serve. I wouldn't want to prolong
20 this, but it was heard yesterday by way of example about
21 the Chairman of the Commission who served as President of
