believe here that if the principle of the resident judge is valid, it is doubly valid as far as the city is concerned. That is why I oppose the motion.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion? You ready for the question? In the absence of objection, I will assume that the Commission favors the drafting of alternate provisions, and therefore a vote Aye on this motion will be a vote in favor of having in the preferred draft a provision permitting the judge of the Superior Court to, authorized to be eligible to be either a resident or of his principal office or be engaged in the practice of law in the district where the vacancy exists.

A vote No will mean a vote to retain the present draft as the preferred draft, and then include the substance of the motion in the alternate. You ready for the question? All those in favor, signify by a show of hands. Contrary. The motion is carried, 14 to 9.
