that not applicable to the Supreme Court and the Appellate
Court?
THE CHAIRMAN: Limited to the Superior Court
only.

NR. CASE: In those cases the districts are
sufficiently broad.

MR. MARTINEAU: It seems to me the one problem you raise wouldn't be solved by your motion, and I wonder why it wouldn't be better to go ahead and try to make it applicable to the Supreme Court and to the Appellate Court. I think it is invariably going to be true that Baltimore City is going to be an appellate judicial circuit for both of those courts, and this is really where the problem arises.

MR. CASE: The more I think about it, I think there is a lot of force in what you are saying, Bob, particularly the situation that has pertained recently in our State where positions on the Appellate Courts have been filled by promotions from the Circuit Court. So it would be pretty incongruous to have members of the Circuit Court sitting side by side, yet one be eligible for the
