10 not where he lives, according to his logic.

11 MR. CASE: Yes.

12 MR. MITCHELL: Why the residency requirement  
13 if it is a question of where he is known in his profes-  
14 sion?

15 DR. TEMPLETON: Mr. Case used the term, risk,  
16 a moment ago, you mean the risk of appointment or risk of  
17 losing his seat?

18 MR. CASE: I don't recall the context of that  
19 sentence.

20 DR. TEMPLETON: I want to know what you mean  
21 by the term, risk.
