1 situation that developed and again, the Bench was de-2 prived of a very fine person. So it seems to me that the status of the judge or where he should come from really 3 4 centers around where he practices, where he is known, and now where he pays quite a bit of tax. 5 6 THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Mitchell? 7 MR. MITCHELL: Then according to Mr. Case's logic, it seems to me that the image built should be 8 9 based on where he practices the Appellate Courts, and 10 not where he lives, according to his logic. 11 MR. CASE: Yes. 12 MR. MITCHELL: Why the residency requirement 13 if it is a question of where he is known in his profes-14 sion? 15 DR. TEMPLETON: Mr. Case used the term, risk, 16 a moment ago, you mean the risk of appointment or risk of 17 losing his seat? MR. CASE: I don't recall the context of that 18 19 sentence. 20 DR. TEMPLETON: I want to know what you mean 21 by the term, risk.
