

1 MR. CASE: Use it any way you want to.

2 DR. BARD: A little while ago, I voted in
3 favor of eliminating the requirement for residence for
4 Superior Court, but I am beginning to worry about the
5 very thing that Dr. Jenkins mentioned, that is if we
6 are going to extend this whole concept of applying metro-
7 politanism to where it seems to fit into our expediency
8 and not extend it to where the necessity takes place we
9 are going to be in difficulty, and I oppose extending
10 what we voted for a while ago into this new area.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion? If
12 not, I will assume in the absence of objection that the
13 Commission is in favor of having both provisions as
14 alternates, and therefore a vote Aye will be a vote in
15 favor of amending the second paragraph of Paragraph A of
16 Section 9 so as to provide that a person to be eligible
17 for nomination shall either reside or have been engaged
18 principally in the practice of law in the circuit where
19 the vacancy exists.

20 A vote No will retain the present paragraph
21 and include the substance of the motion as an alternate.
